82031 at Cashmore's Yard in Newport (Mon) in October 1968. With years of life still in her, she awaits her inevitable fate and in a matter of hours she will have joined the ghastly heap of scrap towering behind her. She was the last of the class still in existence: what a pity we weren't there to rescue her. This is probably the last photograph ever taken of an 82XXX, and it doesn't make easy viewing for anyone who loves steam locomotives.



Distressing as this scene is, it was not destined to be the end of the story for these useful tanks, which have been described as among the best engines the heritage railway movement never had. At Bridgnorth, sister 82045 is now on the home straight and we are in the final phase of raising funds to see the job finished. Established income streams will account for every part of the build between now and mid-2017, except for the firebox with its expensive copper inner skin, copper tube plate and complex Belpaire profile.

Please see the reverse of this leaflet to find out how you can help get 82045 on the rails and in steam as soon as possible, so that this haunting image will never again be the last-known sighting of a Riddles Class 3 2-6-2 tank.
